


Gatekeeper Training



- 279 students engaged Open Up via the chat widget in two months (Sept 7 to Dec 26 22)





3. 開學期間限定心事台 – New School Year 2022

Date: 25/8/2022 - 30/9/2022

Target: All Primary & Secondary School

- Daily chat was raised to 98 chats, around a 20% increased
- A total of 589 primary and secondary students sought help from Open Up in Sept (raised by 24% compared to the last month.)
- The top four concerns of students in the chat were peer relationships, mental stress, physical health and study
- High-Risk chats increased by 37% (by Al detected)
- Develop close cooperation with the school to monitor the risk levels of the student
- A total of 17 high-risk cases refer to School Social workers to follow up


